Project Backpack

- ✓ Provides a week-long creative and fun academic summer camp for children between the ages of 4-13 years old.
- Provides all the materials necessary for the children to fully participate.
- Healthy snacks are also provided.
- Provides the basic tools to start the new school year: a quality backpack, box of colored pencils, pens, notebooks, and pencil holder.
- Provides opportunities for young adults and university students to volunteer in their areas of expertise as teachers.
- √ Allows those volunteers to gain first-hand experience in logistics.
- ✓ From 2010 to 2014 over 1800 children have participated in the Backpack Project, and for 2015 the goal is to reach over 2000 students.

Project Notebook

- √ Teaches volunteers about recycling opportunities and protecting the environment through simple and practical steps.
- Through the project paper is recycled and then assembled into small notebooks that are then used by children during the Backpack Project.

Bilingual Voices Project

- √ Twice weekly after school classes for children ages 5 to 12 years that focus
 on learning how to read and write Spanish formally.
- √ Sharing information about Latino culture in the United States.
- √ Monthly meeting with parents to focus on information related to understanding the education system and how to improve communication with children
